SCHOOL OF NURSING AND MIDWIFERY-ROCHE GHANA GRANT
GRADUATE RESEARCH GRANT

BACKGROUND

The University of Ghana School of Nursing and Midwifery (UG SoNM) has received research funding from ROCHE GHANA to support graduate students in Nursing or Midwifery to complete their research. Each successful MPHIL candidate will receive financial support of GHC 5, 000.00 while successful PHD candidates will receive GHC 10,000.00 to research in cancer or neuroscience.

The grant aims to support students with research focus in cancer (Breast, Liver, Cervical, Prostate, Ovarian, lung, and paediatric cancers) and neuroscience (Parkinson's disease, Multiple sclerosis, and neuromyelitis optica spectrum disease).

The grant is focused on improving the understanding of the science behind these diseases and working towards improved nursing and midwifery care.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants for this grant:

- ✓ Must be a graduate student in nursing or midwifery.
- ✓ Must be enrolled at UG SoNM.
- ✓ Have excellent academic credential s and mustdemonstrate commitment to pursue a research-based career.
- ✓ Be ready to produce scholarly papers from the research.
- ✓ Be ready to acknowledge ROCHE Ghana in all publications.

GUIDELINES FOR APPLICATION

Applicants should submit one PDF file of the following documents to the project manager (oncologygrant89@gmail.com):

- ✓ An application letter
- ✓ Most recent CV
- ✓ A certified copy of graduate transcript
- ✓ A maximum of 3-Page research proposal clearly outlining the background, objectives, scope and methodology. A work plan and a budget must be attached on separate sheets.
- ✓ Written evidence of approval of topic from supervisor.
- ✓ Letter of support from Head of Department.

The deadline for the submission of applications is latest by close of day on <u>Friday 10th</u> **DECEMBER. 2021**.
